Walvis Bay





Situated within Walvis Bay port district, Dormac Marine and Engineering Namibia (Pty) Ltd was established in 2009 due to the growing demand from many of Dormac's existing clients for servicing of their vessels on the Namibian coast.

Dormac Facilities

- 4061m² yard with 3000m² workshop
- 13m Underhook workshop with the capacity to lift 50t on the two 25t gantry cranes

Namport Facilities

Dormac – Namibia utilises the Namibian Port Authority's facilities in conjunction with its ship repair services.

Repair Quays

- 4 quays each 80m long
- Draft between 8m and 1m at berths

- Berth 8 & 9 are used for oil rig repairs
- Mobile cranes available up to 90t capacity to support large projects
- Quay is serviced by shore power, freshwater, firewater and compressed air

Synchrolift

- Can lift vessels up to 2,000t displacement, 80m in length overall, and 12m in width
- On average, the Synchrolift handles about 50 vessels per month

Walvis Bay is situated on the West Coast of Africa within close proximity to the Angolan oil fields and to the major international shipping lines in the Atlantic. To date, several large oil rigs operating in the Angolan oil fields have used Walvis Bay to carry out major repairs, modifications and scheduled maintenance.





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
